We are pleased to offer up to 50 IFCC Travel Scholarships to allow young scientists from IFCC member countries to attend both the XXVI EuroMedLab Congress to be held in Brussels, 18-22 May 2025 and the 4th edition of the IFCC FORUM for YOUNG SCIENTISTS to be held in Brussels, on 18 May 2025.

Applicants should be:

- From IFCC member countries
- Less than 40 yrs. of age as of 1st January 2025
- Submitting an accepted abstract, that indicates you as the first Author, for presentation at the Brussels 2025 EuroMedLab Congress – see here the link for the related web page: https://www.euromedlab2025brussels.org/abstracts/
- First time to receive an IFCC Travel Scholarship

Those previously awarded a Travel Scholarship are not eligible to apply.

The Travel Scholarship will provide funding towards:

- 1) a contribution for the cost of economy travel
- 2) four nights hotel BB accommodation (80€/night as maximum)
- 3) free registration to the Congress and to the IFCC FORUM for Young Scientists

Scholarships will be paid after the Conference on provision of evidence of congress attendance and relevant receipts. Successful applicants will be asked to write an account of their experience to be published in IFCC eNews.

Interested applicants are required to complete the attached application form. The application and the supporting documents should be completed by 1st March 2025.
